NOTES

- All new residents (session 1) are expected to attend Orientation Week and all new residents (session 2) to attend Orientation Weekend. If special circumstances prevent attendance, a refund of \$30/day is available for each orientation day you are unable to attend.
- Returning Resident Discount of \$175 per session applies to each session after two completed sessions in College.
- Early Settlement Discount of \$50 per session applies if the account is paid in full prior to the end of the second week of session. Early Settlement Discount of \$150 for full year (Sessions 1 & 2) applies if the account is paid in full prior to the end of the second week of Session 1.
- Accommodation out of session (mid-year & summer vacation) is charged at the rate of \$36 per night (includes breakfast) and must be paid within the first 4 weeks of the summer vacation, otherwise a \$50 accounting fee will apply.

FURTHER NOTES & CONDITIONS

1. When accepting a place in the colleges' residents should note that they have contracted for the full session and have a financial obligation to pay for the entire academic session.
2. Residents who withdraw from UNSW within the first 5 weeks of session will be liable for 9 weeks rent.
3. Residents who accept an offer of accommodation in the Colleges after the first week of Session are entitled to a rebate on a pro-rata basis.
4. The session fee provides access to internal telephone and data services (excludes internet & external telephone usage). Users must comply with University policy for use of the telephone and data networks.
5. If a resident vacates the College within 14 days of the end of the Examination period and returns his/her key and identification/meal card, the College will credit an accommodation rebate of \$16 per day to the resident's account. Unless otherwise arranged, departure time is by 10am on the day of departure for the purpose of determining daily payments.
6. An accounting fee of \$50 will be charged each time a resident fails to pay monies owing within the first 4 weeks of session as outlined in the schedule or comply with note 7 below. Resident's account will be sent by email or alternatively from reception if a resident does not receive an account within the first 2 weeks of session.
7. **Resident experiencing financial difficulties** may make an application to pay fees by instalments with their respective Head of College within the first 2 weeks of session (note 6 above). If such an application is accepted, the resident will be required to sign an agreement setting out any revised arrangements.
8. The issuing of University examination results, and permission for re-enrolment or graduation, will be blocked if fees or charges remain unpaid 14 days before the end of the Session.
9. Should resident membership of the Colleges be terminated (e.g. on grounds of misconduct), the resident will still be liable in respect of any non-payment of fees and/or charges. A pro-rata refund of fees to the resident for early termination will be considered only in exceptional circumstances, such as a lapsing of eligibility for enrolment in courses at the University.
10. Any resident who has lost the room key or any identification/meal cards issued to the resident of the Colleges will be subject to a replacement fee of \$125/key and \$11/meal card, payable within 14 days.
11. All residents must be added to the Colleges explode email list as this is one of the official communication methods.
12. TKC is not responsible or liable for resident's personal belongings and residents are encouraged to take out personal content insurance.
13. The advance payment may be forfeited in part or in full in the event of cancellation by the resident of his/her acceptance of a place in the Colleges on the grounds of accepting a place elsewhere as a student of UNSW.
14. The holding fee/security deposit may be forfeited for damage to the property of the Colleges or any property that is the responsibility of the Colleges; special cleaning required to the room allocated to the resident; any missing items of College property that is allocated to the resident; failure by the resident to return when required any room key and/or identification/meal card.
